### Belvedere House & Gardens

An oasis of beauty in the Midlands is there to be enjoyed. Belvedere House Gardens & Park can be discovered on the shores of Lough Ennell, 4 miles from Mullingar in Co Westmeath and just one hours drive from Dublin. Belvedere opened to the public in 2000. The estate comprises of 160 acres of parkland with 6kms of woodland and lakeshore walks. Several follies adorn the landscape including Ireland's largest folly – The Jealous Wall. The restored Belvedere House is an 18<sup>th</sup> century hunting/fishing lodge and the walled garden contains one of Ireland's finest collections of rare and special plants. The stable block is home to a modern Visitor Centre with multi-media show, exhibitions and Café. There is also a delightful tram which provides guided tours around the section of the park ground.

Belvedere is open to the public 7 days a week all year round.

### Corlea Trackway Visitor Centre

The centre interprets an Iron Age bog road, which was built in the year 148BC across the bog lands close to the River Shannon. The oak road is the largest of its kind to have been uncovered in Europe and was excavated over the years. Inside the building, an 18 – metre stretch of preserved road is on permanent display in a specially designed hall with humidifiers to prevent the ancient wood from cracking in the heat.

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#### Birr Castle Demesne & Historic Science Centre

Birr Castle Demesne and Ireland's Historic Science Centre is host to Ireland's largest gardens, offering a Winter Garden, Formal Garden, Terrace Garden a River Garden. The beautiful parkland features thousands of rare trees and plants collected from all over the world. The rivers, lakes and waterfalls are all memorable.

The Great Telescope constructed at Birr Castle in the 1840's, the largest in the world for 70 years, is now fully restored and looks and moves just as it did 150 years ago.

Ireland's Historic Science Centre features pioneering achievements in fields of astronomy, photography engineering and horticulture.

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#### Clonmacnoise

Clonmacnoise is a sixth century monastic site, with three high crosses, a cathedral, seven churches and two round towers. This great monastery was founded in 548-9 by St Ciaran. Clonmacnoise was a great centre of learning, and many manuscripts, including the Annals of Tighernach (11<sup>th</sup> Century) and the Book of the Dun Cow (12<sup>th</sup> Century), were written here. The site is entered through the visitor centre, where a number of cross-slabs is displayed. The centrepiece of the new Interpretative Centre is the 9<sup>th</sup> Century Cross of the Scriptures.

### Ballinlough Castle Gardens

A sense of tranquillity prevails as one enters the gates of Ballinlough. Perched on a hill overlooking two lakes, the 17<sup>th</sup> century castle is the home of Sir John and Lady Nugent. The gardens were restored in 1994, and now open to the public, together with the lakeside and woodland walks. The walled garden is divided into four walled sections. On view are herbaceous borders, a grass tennis court, lily pond, rose garden, a herb and soft fruit garden and a well stocked orchard. From the walled gardens, a white door leads to the lakeside walks with the charming water garden and its rustic summerhouse.

### TriAthlone takes place from 7<sup>th</sup> – 13<sup>th</sup> July 2008.

Triathlone combines the best of 3 sports: swimming, cycling and running. The main triAthlone race is a Sprint Distance Race: 750m Swim, 20km Bike, 5km Run. The charity Try-a-tri-Athlone has a shorter-downstream swim of 200m with the same bike and run course. The event commences with a swim along the river Shannon, which flows through Athlone town, followed by a 20km cycle and 5km run around and through the streets of Athlone. Over 1,500 competitors are expected to take part with up to 100 elite athletes competing in a separate event later on Saturday evening. The river Shannon will provide a spectacular backdrop to the swim part of the triathlon.
